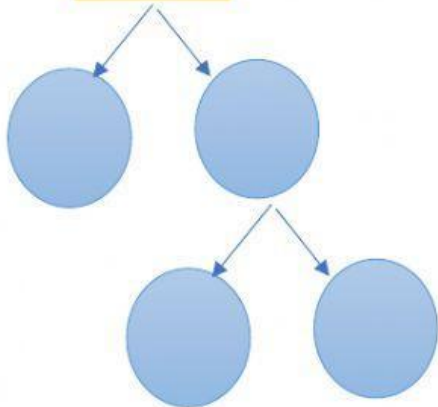


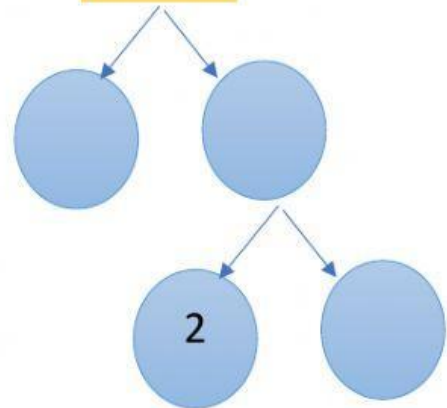
Complete the factorization to express these numbers as product of ONLY prime numbers:
