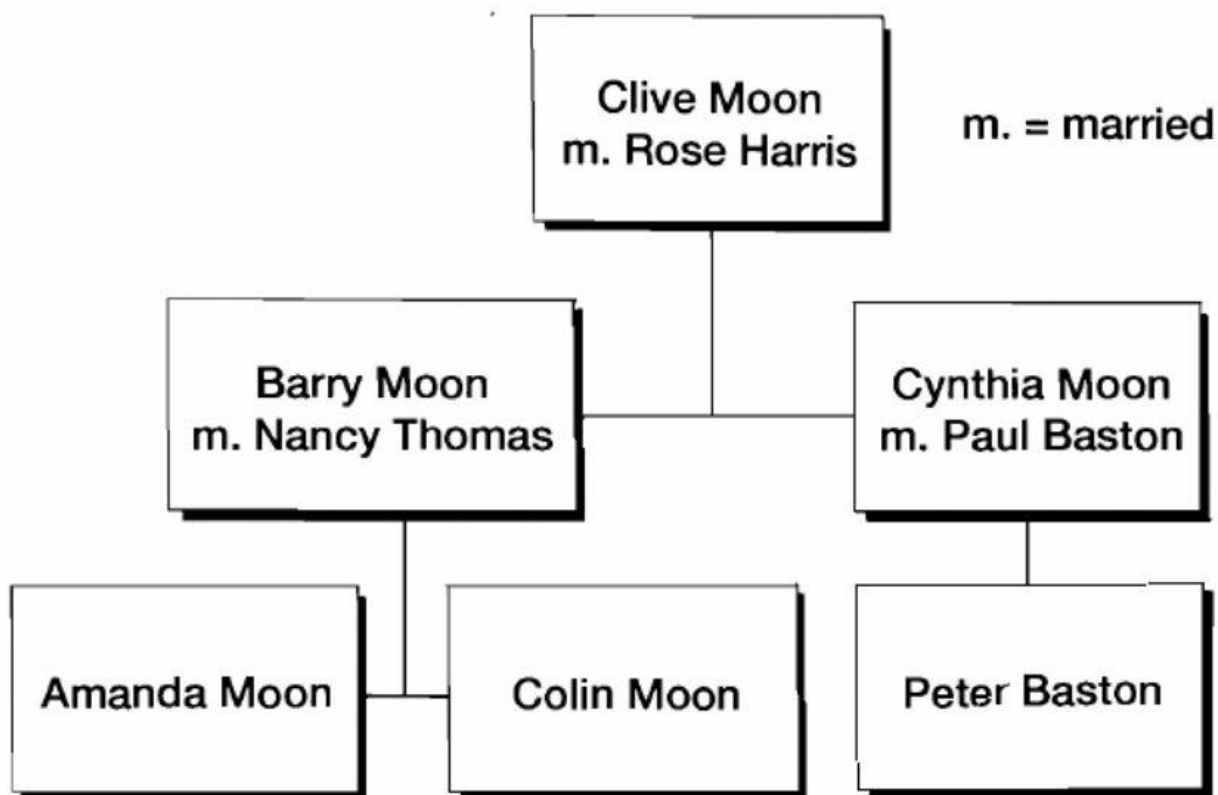


## The family
