

## Adding “ing”

### Information:

a, e, i, o, u (and sometimes y) are vowels

All the other letters are consonants!

When a word with one syllable ends in **CVC** (consonant-vowel-consonant), then you need to double the last consonant before adding “ing”.

stop - stopping

If a word ends in magic e, you need to drop the “e” before adding “ing”.

take - taking

Let's try it! Check if the word ends in CVC or magic e!
