Comparatives adjectives/ Adjetivos comparativos

Un adjetivo comparativo es una palabra que describe un sustantivo comparándolo con otro sustantivo. A los adjetivos comparativos usualmente se les agrega **er** al final de cada uno. También van acompañados de la palabra **than**.

Slow	Slower er
Happy	Happi er
Sad	Sadd er
Crazy	Crazi er

Adjective	Comparative
Hot	Hotter
Cold	Colder
Good	Better
Bad	Worse
Far	Farther
Smart	Smarter
Silly	Sillier
Young	Younger
Old	Older

2) Bogota is colder than Armenia.

Mysterious	More/less mysterious
Confusing	More confusing

Un adjetivo superlativo es una palabra que describe un sustantivo comparándolo con dos o más sustantivos al grado más alto o más bajo. Adejetivos superlativos comúnmente se le agregan **est** al final de cada uno. También van acompañados de la palabra **the**.

Observe very carefully the following chart

Adjective	Superlative
Old	Oldest
Young	Youngest
Big	Biggest
Small	Smallest
Cold	Coldest
Hot	Hottest
Tall	Tallest
Short	Shortest
Good	Best
Bad	Worst

Examples:

- 1) English is one of the best subjects in the world.
- 2) Homer Simpson is the oldest member of his family.
