- **-NESS** ADJECTIVE → ABSTRACT NOUN
ex : *good* → *goodness*
- **-DOM, -HOOD, -SHIP** CONCRETE NOUN → ABSTRACT NOUN
ex : *a king* → *a kingdom* *a child* → *childhood* *a friend* → *friendship*
