

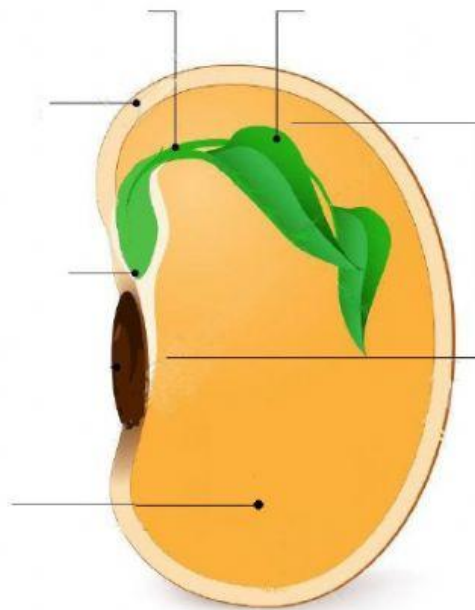
## ~ SEED GERMINATION ~
