An 82- long cargo ship is and in the English Channel after it collided with a fishing vessel on Tuesday.

France's Maritime Prefect says it was alerted at local time of a collision involving the Maltese-flagged freighter Britannica HAV and the fishing Deborah, flying the Belgian flag. The happened about 50 northeast of Cherbourg, France, to the of the Dover Strait.

All seven of the cargo ship evacuated to two life rafts and were recovered by the fishing vessel.

According to the Maritime Prefect, the Britannica sustained damage on its side at its centre.

The of the fishing vessel sustained a minor head injury, but otherwise no injuries were reported.

The French Abeille Liberté has been sent to the scene along with a French coastal police boat to monitor the wreck.
