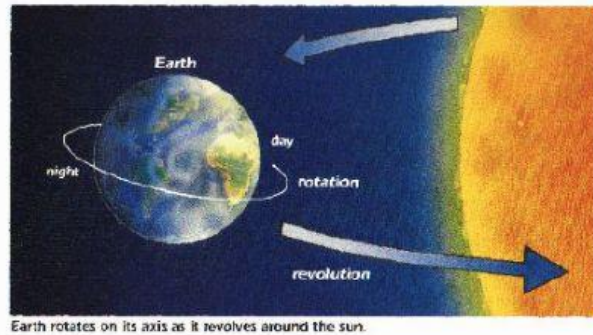
What is the main idea of this paragraph?
