Verb tense

present be

present simple

past simple

past continuous

+ sentence → - tag

Your name is Pedro, **isn't it?**

You live downstairs, **don't you?**

She studied biology, **didn't she?**

You were joking, **weren't you?**

- sentence → + tag

She's never late, **is she?**

You don't live here, **do you?**

They didn't know, **did they?**

You weren't joking, **were you?**

a positive statement + a negative question tag

You **are** a student, **aren't you?**

A subject pronoun comes after an auxiliary or a form of the verb To Be

a negative statement + a positive question tag

Mary **isn't** a teacher, **is she?**

A subject pronoun is used to replace the noun or noun phrase
