

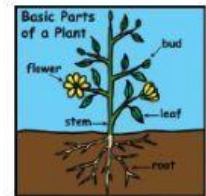

Glossary	
Agate	Small type (usually 8-12 points) used for extra detail
All	White space used in a story design
All caps	Type using only capital letters
Armburst	An orange plastic sheet, placed over a pasted-up page or photo in another color
Anchor	An image, word or phrase (usually in color and large)
Application	A computer software program that performs a task
Arrival	An enclosed looking page layout where a story's text
Ascender	The part of a letter extending above the x-height (x)
Attribution	A line identifying the source of a quote
Boxcar	A wide headline extending across the entire page
