Remember: When talking about the daily activities or general truths about **one** person or thing, place an 's' at the end of the action word.

If the action word ends with **ch, sh, s, x** or **z**, add 'es' at the end of the word.

For example: She brushes her teeth twice a day.

Daddy wishes he could win a car.

The bird fixes the nest.
