



BASICS

Cybersecurity is the protection of computer systems and networks from the theft of or damage to their hardware, software,

or electronic data, as well as from the disruption (*narušení*) or misdirection (*zaměření nesprávným směrem*) of the services they provide.

Cybercrime is a crime that involves a computer and a network. The computer may have been used in the commission (*spáchání*) of a crime, or it may be the target. Cybercrime may threaten a person, company or a nation's security and financial health.
