**Josh:** That would be nice, but I am afraid I cannot come.

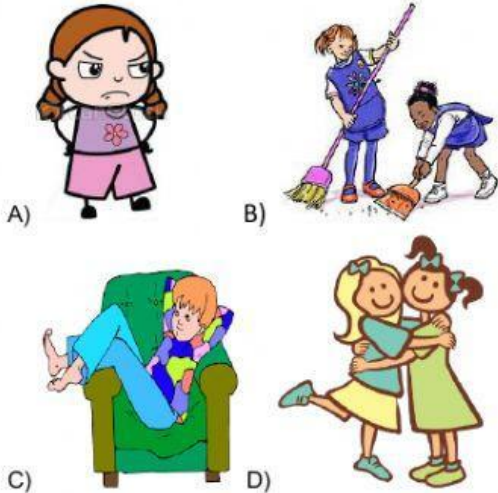
