

## Fresh and salty water: Match the definitions to the pictures:

### Ocean and Seas

The ocean is a large body of salt water. Seas are smaller areas of the ocean that are partly surrounded by land.



### Glaciers and Ice Caps

A **glacier** is a large body of slowly moving ice. Glaciers form when more snow falls than melts in an area. The polar **ice caps** are large areas of ice at the North and South Poles.



### Rivers

A river is flowing fresh water. Water in rivers moves downhill. Rivers flow into the ocean, lakes, and other rivers.



### Lakes and Ponds

Land surrounds lakes and ponds, which are smaller than the ocean. Lakes are generally larger than ponds. Almost all lakes and ponds contain fresh water, but a few lakes and ponds contain salt water.
