Write a question for each of these answers. Use a contraction if you can.

 **Word order**

- Subject, verb *They're American.*
- Verb, subject *Are they American?*
- Question, verb, subject *Where are they from?*

Contractions with question words

You can contract *is* after question words.

What's her name? = *What is her name?*
Where's he from? = *Where is he from?*
How's Anna? = *How is Anna?*
How old's Jan? = *How old is Jan?*

Don't contract *is* in a question when the last word is a pronoun (*he, she, it, etc.*).

How old is she? NOT *How old's she?*
Where is he? NOT *Where's he?*
