


## Superlatives



We call this a superlative.



We use the superlative when we compare three or more things or people. We use "the" before the superlative.

To form the superlative of adjectives, we add **-est** to the adjective. Be careful with the spelling changes!!

### Adjective      Superlative

Small      ——— | the **smallest** (el más pequeño)

Long      ——— | the **longest** (el más largo)

Big      ——— | the **biggest** (el más grande)

Hot      ——— | the **hottest**

Nice      ——— | the **nicest**

Large      ——— | the **largest**

Heavy      ——— | the **heaviest**

Easy      ——— | the **easiest**

When the adjective has two or more syllables, we put "the **most**" before the adjective.

### Adjective      Superlative

Expensive      ——— | the **most** expensive

Beautiful      ——— | the **most** beautiful

Examples of sentences:

Mount Everest is **the highest** mountain in the world.

Summer is **the hottest** season of the year.

My team won the championship. I'm **the happiest** person in the world!!

**The largest** continent is Asia.

We bought **the most** beautiful card in the shop.
