

Other ways of saying IF

UNLESS : if not

I won't go to the party **unless** you come with us. (If you don't come with us)

IN CASE: (because something might happen)

Take a compass **in case** you get lost. (because you might get lost)

We took an umbrella **in case** it rained.

EVEN IF: whether or not- more emphatic

Even if you apologise, I will never forgive you. (Whether or not you apologise, I will never...)

We will go bankrupt **even if** we get the loan.

AS LONG AS /PROVIDED THAT/ PROVIDING THAT: on condition that, only if

He will tell me truth **as long as/ providing that/ provided that** I promise to keep the secret.

You will be able to get the scholarship **as long as/provided that/providing that** you study for your exam.
