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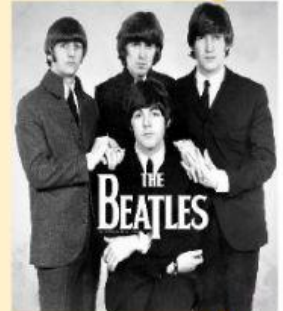

Nowadays, they are also regarded as the most influential rock band and the best-selling band in history, with estimated sales of over 600 million records worldwide.
