I go to the beach every year.

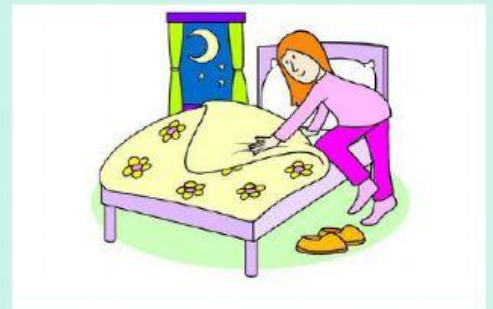
