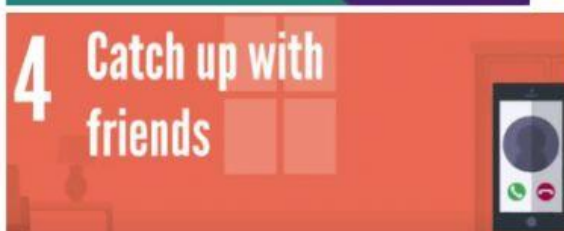

PRESENT PERFECT:

We can use Present Perfect to talk about **experiences**.

PRESENT PERFECT	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES
Affirmative	I/YOU/WE/THEY + HAVE + ALREADY + PAST PARTICIPLE VERB HE/SHE/IT + HAS + ALREADY + PAST PARTICIPLE VERB	I HAVE ALREADY DRUNK THREE COFFEES SHE HAS ALREADY DRUNK THREE COFFEES
Negative	I/YOU/WE/THEY + HAVEN'T + PAST PARTICIPLE VERB + YET HE/SHE/IT + HASN'T + PAST PARTICIPLE VERB + YET	SHE HASN'T READ THAT BOOK YET WE HAVEN'T BEEN TO MAR DEL PLATA YET
Interrogative	HAVE + I/YOU/WE/THEY + PAST PARTICIPLE VERB + YET? HAS + HE/SHE/IT + PAST PARTICIPLE VERB + YET?	HAVE YOU EATEN FRIED CHICKEN YET? HAS HE WRITTEN THIS BOOK YET?

ADVERBS	USE	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES
Already (Ya)	Sugiere que no es necesario repetir la acción	Affirmative: Subject + has/have + already + past participle	I've already drunk three coffees this morning <i>Ya me he tomado tres cafés esta mañana</i>
Yet (Negative: Aún no Interrogative: ya)	Sugiere que aún no se ha realizado la acción	Interrogative: Has/have + subject + past participle + ... yet? Negative: Subject + haven't/hasn't + past participle + ... yet.	Have you met Judy yet? ¿Ya has visto a Judy? They haven't eaten yet. <i>Aún no han comido.</i>
