NOUNS

Describe a thing, person, place or idea.

PRONOUNS

Replace nouns.

VERBS

Express actions or states of being.

ADJECTIVES

Describe nouns or pronouns.

ARTICLES

Used before nouns.

ADVERBS

Describe a verb, adjective or another adverb.

PREPOSITIONS

Show relationship between words.

CONJUNCTIONS

Join words or phrases.

INTERJECTIONS

Express strong feelings or emotions.
