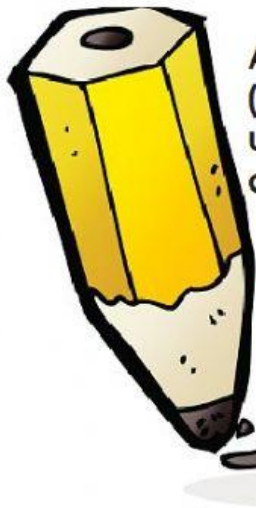


Grammar sheet#2: **Amazing Adjectives**
