

PAST SIMPLE

Use:

We use the Past Simple to talk about a completed event in the past.

We often say when it happened (e.g yesterday, two years ago...)

e.g I ...bought.....(buy) a present for you last Tuesday.

Spelling rules:

*If the verb ends with -e, we add -d:

e.g live-lived

*Verbs endings with a consonant +y ,we put : -ied
e.g study-studied

*Verbs ending with one vowel and one consonant, double the consonant:
e.g stop-stopped

Regular and Irregular verbs:

There are two types of verbs in English: Regular and Irregular Verbs.

* We form the Past Simple of regular verbs by adding -ed to the verb:

e.g open-opened
 walk-walked
 ask-asked

*The Past Simple form of many verbs is irregular:

e. g do-did
 take-took
 say-said

Form

Negative:

*We form the negative with ***didn't*** +verb in infinitive

e.g I didn't go to the gym yesterday.

*We form questions with ***did and the infinitive***

e.g Did you go to the cinema yesterday?

Affirmative

I(eat) yesterday.

You(drink) yesterday.

He(swim) yesterday.

She(run) yesterday.

It(jump) yesterday.

We(come) yesterday.

You(go) yesterday.

They(walk) yesterday.

Negative

I (eat) yesterday.

You (drink) yesterday.

He (swim) yesterday.

She (run) yesterday.

It (jump) yesterday.

We (come) yesterday.

You (go) yesterday.

They (walk) yesterday.

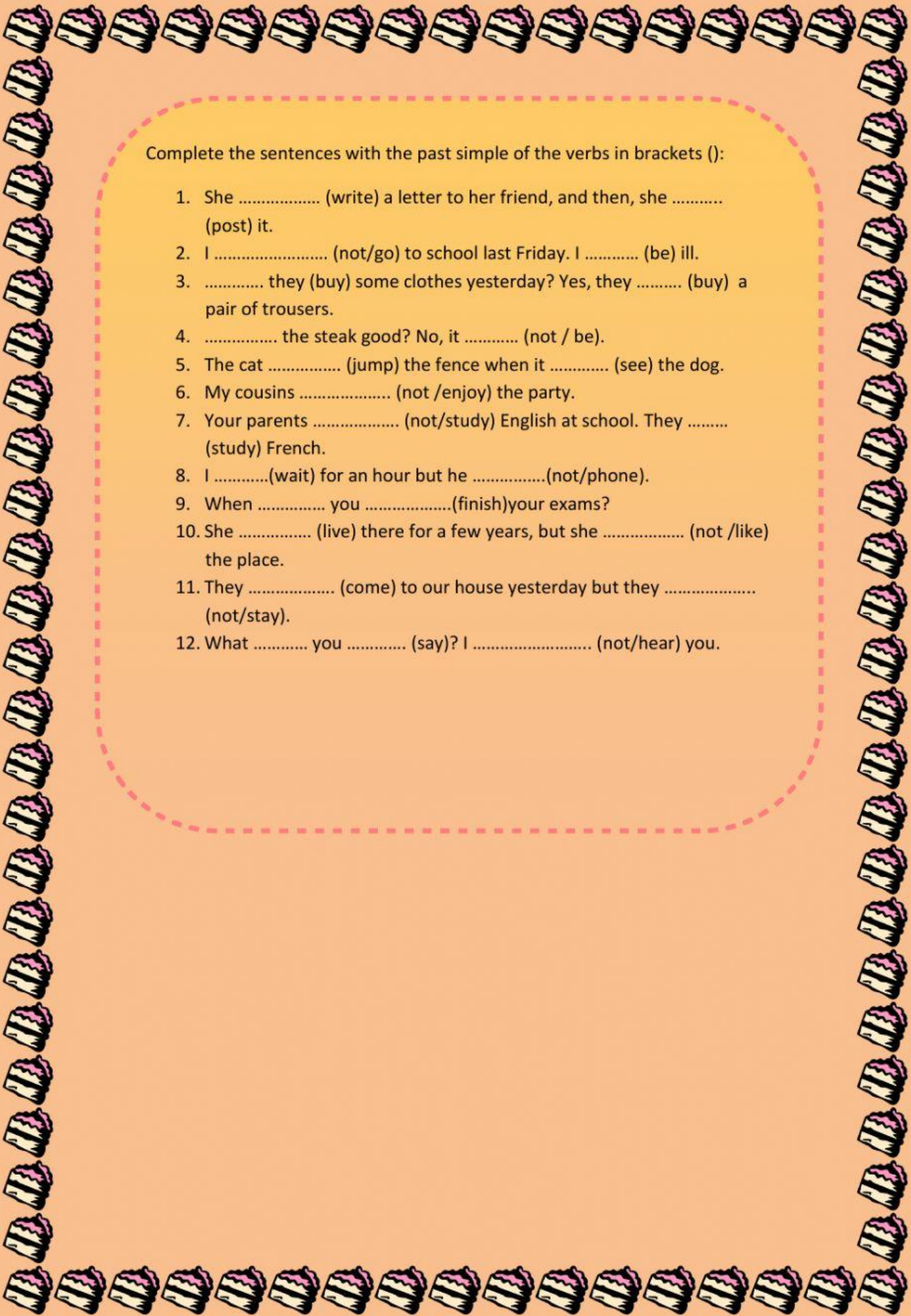
