The Beatles was an english music band of rock and pop, the most admired and popular of the 60's and one of the most influential in the history of modern music.

Around 1962 the band had a stable group , until its official separation in 1970. The members of the band were John Lennon (Liverpool), Paul McCartney (Liverpool), George Harrison (Liverpool) and Ringo Star (Liverpool). During the second half of the 50's, John Lennon and his friend Peter Shotton created a music band called "The Quarrymen", Paul McCartney joined it in 1957, and a little later George Harrison.

"The Quarrymen" started to perform in different places in Liverpool, moment in which Stuart Sutcliffe joined the band.

The name of the band had a lot of changes, from “Johnny and the Moondogs” to “The Silver Beatles” and finally “The Beatles” in 1960. This came up because it was popular to name the musical bands with animal names and it was related to the musical style that they practiced then (music beat).

Finally they added a set of drums played by Peter Best, and got a contract to play in Hamburg in a place with a very bad reputation named “Kaiserkeller”. Their first german adventure ended with George Harrison thrown out for being a minor.

In 1961, they went back to Germany and came back to United Kingdom with no luck. Peter Best abandoned the group and he was substituted by Ringo Starr. The list of members was ready: John, Paul, George and Ringo.
