PROGRESSIVE	<u>El estará jugando</u> HE WILL BE PLAYING	WILL BE + ING Verbo siempre con ING <i>Dance dancing</i> <i>Run running</i> <i>Die dying</i> <i>Lie lying</i>
PERFECT	<u>El habrá jugado</u> HE WILL HAVE PLAYED	WILL HAVE + p.p. won'tHAVE + p.p. Verbo va en "past participle" siempre: Drink drank drunk
PERFECT PROGRESSIVE	<u>El habrá estado jugando</u> HE WILL HAVE BEEN PLAYING	WILL HAVE BEEN +ING Won't HAVE BEEN +ING
