

Nursery Rhyme Logic Grid Practice

This grid provides a worksheet for sorting information. Every square represents what is true or not true. By eliminating possibilities, also know as DEDUCTIVE Logic, one is finally left with the only choice per row or column. The one square left will be the correct answer. Use an X to represent eliminating a choice (what can not be true) and an O to represent a correct answer. Remember, if you have an O then everything in the same row and column becomes an X. This is very important in tracking your solution.

1. Brenda's favorite nursery rhyme is about a "little girl"
2. Dana's favorite rhyme does not have a girl in it.
3. Anna does not like rhymes that have the word, "little" in them.
4. Cathy does not like sheep.
