Are they made in Spain? Are they made in France? Or are they made in Italy?

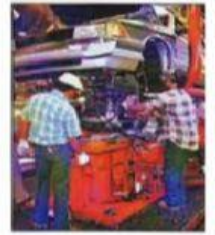
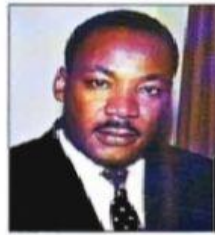
Dawn: That's easy. Italy.
