

Present Perfect Continuous

Make the present perfect continuous Negative.

Example:

0. (I / live here for six years and a half)

I haven't been living here for six years and a half.

1. (it / rain / lately)

2. (I / swim / today)

3. (you / cook / this year)

4. (we / study / enough for our exams)

5. (he / run / recently because he hurt his knee)

6. (they / sleep / well because they are stressed out)

7. (I / eat / healthy. I should avoid junk food)

8. (she / read / much this week. She hasn't organized)

9. (My dog / play / much. It must be sick)

10. (you / drink / enough water. You should drink more)
