In the X Games the best extreme sports professionals in the world compete every year. Skiers,



snowboarders, BMX bike riders, and skateboarders show their best new tricks during the competition. They can win medals and also money.



One of these competitors is Brighton Zeuner. Brighton **was** born in San Diego, California on July 14 in 2004. She **started**

skateboarding when she **was** four. She **practised** at home until she **got** her own skateboard. Her brother **wanted** a vert ramp so their parents **decided** to buy a vert ramp for the kids. She **learned** to do better tricks with the ramp. She **was** soon a better skateboarder than her brother and **started** to love competing. At the age of 8 she **competed** for the first time and, in 2017, she **won** her first medal and she **was** the youngest champion in X Games history.



Vert Ramps

Sometimes a teacher **went** to her house to help her with school because Brighton **travelled** a lot and it **was** difficult to go to school every day. But she **continued** practising and studying and now she is one of the best and youngest competitors of the X games.

Regular Verbs

When forming the past tense of regular verbs, add -d or -ed to the present tense form of the verb.

Example:
cook, cooked



LOOK AT THESE EXAMPLES:

COOK: COOKED

LOOK: LOOKED

VISIT: VISITED

DECIDE: DECIDED



Irregular Verbs

Irregular verbs have special past tense forms. They do not end in -d or -ed. You will need to memorize these special forms.

Example:
drive, drove



LOOK AT THESE EXAMPLES:

DRIVE: DROVE

BUY: BOUGHT

GO: WENT

RUN: RAN
