A youth subculture depends largely on the social class and ethnic background of its members; it is often characterized by its adoption of a particular music genre.

1) _____

This is a youth subculture (mostly from the middle class) originating in San Francisco in the 1960s. They believed in universal love and peace, lived in communes, wore long hair and listened to acid rock and progressive rock music.

2) _____

This British youth subculture first appeared in the 1950s. They adopted a pseudo-Edwardian dress code and rock'n'roll music; they were also involved in race riots in the United Kingdom.

3) _____

This youth subculture is closely associated with punk rock music in the late 1970s and was in part a reaction to the hippy subculture. Their clothes intended to shock, so they wore plastic garbage bags or old school uniforms and dyed their hair in bright colours (in Mohican haircuts or sometimes spiked in bright plumes).

4) _____

This was originally a British youth subculture that evolved out of the teddy boys in the 1960s; wore black leather jackets and jeans and boots; had greased hair and rode motorcycles and listened to rock'n'roll; were largely unskilled manual labourers.
