Petra: Lost City of Stone

Petra is a very popular tourist attraction in Jordan. This ancient city is located between the Dead Sea and the Red Sea.

It is also known as the Rose City due to the color of the rock from which the city was carved.

An ancient Arab tribe, named Nabateans, built Petra. This people were nomadic but industrious and benefited from the proximity of Petra to the regional trade routes, which made them wealthy. The Nabateans were also famous for their abilities in constructing efficient water collecting methods. In fact, one of the spectacular characteristics of Petra is its water conduit system. Experts estimate that this system carried out about 40 million liters of fresh spring water per day, enough to sustain its population of almost 30,000 people.

Another fascinating characteristic of the Rose City is its extraordinary entrance. To enter Petra, you have to pass through a canyon of about 1 km, bound by tall cliffs of about 80 km. Visitors to Petra will enjoy the walk, as well as its fabulous ruins and tombs.

Petra remained hidden to the outside world for centuries until Johann Ludwig, a Swiss explorer, rediscovered it in 1822. This is why it is called the "Lost City". Since 1985, the "Lost City" or the "Rose City" has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site and, in 2007, it was named one of the new seven wonders of the world.
