An **action** that will continue up until sometime in the future

- They for 2 hours by the time they get home. (walk)
- In October, he here for a year. (work)
- By the end of the night, he for 5 hours. (perform)
- Joe will be tired when he returns because he outside the whole afternoon. (play)
- By next week she in the country for six months. (live)
- By next year I English for 7 years. (study)
- By December, Kate for a year. (teach)
- By 6 o'clock, she for four hours. (sleep)
- By the time he gets here, I for two hours. (wait)
- By 2022, The Rolling Stones music for almost sixty years. (make)
- By midnight we for 4 hours. (dance)
- By the time we go home, we for a month. (tour)
- By the time I retire, I profession poker for 30 years. (play)
- By the time you get a job, I the rent for 3 years! (pay)
- By the time I get published, I for 20 years. (write)
