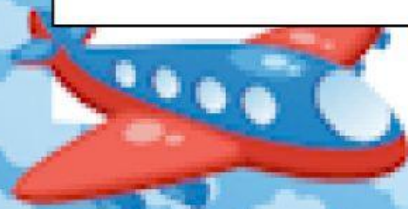


### *The Present Simple Tense of the verb TO HAVE*

| Pronouns         | Affirmative sentence | Negative sentence                                    | Interrogative sentence  |
|------------------|----------------------|--|---|
| I/ You/ We/ They | I <b>have</b> books. | I <b>do not have</b> books.<br>do not = don't        | <b>Do</b> I <b>have</b> books? –<br>Yes, I do./No, I don't.         |
| He/ She/ It      | He <b>has</b> books. | He <b>does not have</b> books.<br>does not = doesn't | <b>Does</b> he <b>have</b> books? –<br>Yes, he does./No, he doesn't |
