1. Last night I lost / have lost my keys – I had to call my flatmate to let me in.
2. I lost / have lost my keys – can you help me look for them?
3. I visited / have visited Paris three times.
4. Last year I visited / have visited Paris.
5. I knew / have known my great grandmother for a few years – she died when I was eight.
6. I knew / have known Julie for three years – we still meet once a month.
7. I played / have played hockey since I was a child – I'm pretty good!
8. She played / has played hockey at school, but she didn't like / hasn't liked it.
9. Sorry, I missed / have missed the bus, so I'm going to be late.
10. I missed / have missed the bus, and then I missed / have missed the airplane as well.
11. Last month I went / have gone to Scotland.
12. I'm sorry, John isn't here now. He went / has gone to the shops.
13. We finished / have finished this room last week.
14. I finished / have finished my exams finally – I'm so happy!
15. Yesterday, I saw / have seen all my friends. It was great.
16. I saw / have seen Julie three times this week!
17. She lived / has lived in London since 1994.
18. She lived / has lived in London when she was a child.
19. I drank / have drunk three cups of coffee this morning.
20. I drank / have drunk seven cups of coffee yesterday.
