ago.



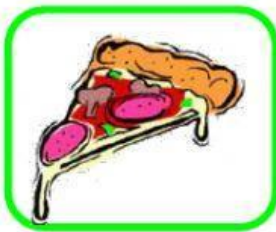
You -----
