6) Read about Blackbeard's life and conjugate the verbs (simple past) :

Blackbeard (be) probably born in Bristol, England, in 1680. His real name is a mystery. He was tall and strong. He (have) long dark hair, scary eyes and a long black beard. He always (wear) a black hat. The legend says that when he (attack) enemy ships, he set fire to his beard to terrify his enemies !

His flag was famous : it was black with a white skeleton on it. Before becoming a pirate, Blackbeard was a British privateer working for the British monarch : he (fight) against French ships. Then, he (join) the crew of a pirate ship in 1716. He soon became a captain. Blackbeard and his crew (capture) over 40 ships in the Caribbean, between Florida and Venezuela, and (steal) their treasure (food, gold, silver, tobacco, sugar, cotton, etc.). Blackbeard last battle was on November 22, 1718 : British soldiers shot him five times with their guns and they (cut) off his head.
