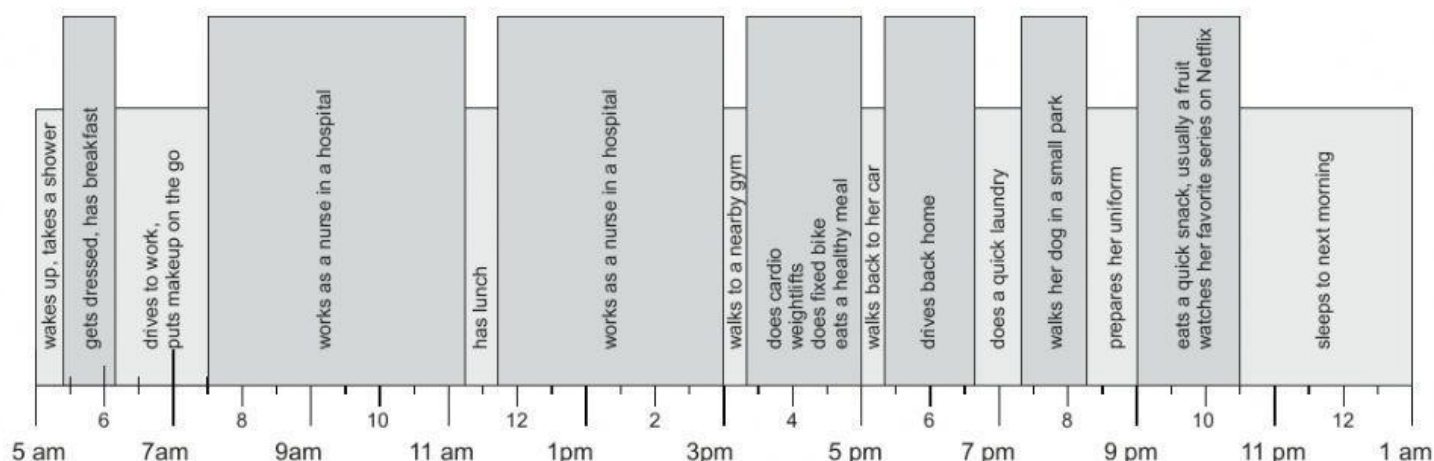


# Sarah's everyday schedule
