1) In the first half of a trivia game Edward scored 16,354 points. In the second half he scored 2,865 points. How many points did he score total?

2) A grocery store had 4,967 bottles of regular soda and 15,096 bottles of diet soda. How many bottles did they have total?

3) For a party Henry spent 17,858 dollars on food and 8,392 dollars on drinks. How much did Henry spend total?

4) A store sold 11,456 cold drinks and 56,729 hot drinks. How many drinks did they sell total?

5) For Halloween George got 96,254 ounces of candy and Katie got 39,687 ounces of candy. What is the combined weight they received?

6) Isabel had 9,560 sheets of paper in her desk and 83,785 more in her backpack. How many did she have total?

7) A restaurant sold 26,586 sodas in the morning and 26,253 in the afternoon. How many sodas did they sell total?

8) At the arcade Paul had won 18609 tickets. Later he won 25,996 more tickets. How many tickets did Paul have total?

9) Amy picked up 35,694 pieces of paper from the floor. If Ned picked up 47,828 pieces, how many did they pick up total?

10) Haley had 83,467 pieces of candy. Her friend gave her 25,704 more pieces. How many pieces of candy did Haley have total?

11) Zoe spent 75,496 minutes drawing at school and 86,894 minutes drawing at home. How many minutes total did she spend drawing?

12) An aquarium had 48,182 fish in it. Later they added 69,778 fish. How many fish are in the aquarium now?
