The Nature of God - Jesus' Miracles

What is a miracle? **A miracle is an extraordinary event that cannot be explained.**

Jesus performed miracles on earth such as: **controlling nature, multiplying food, healing the sick, and raising others and His self from the dead!**

Controlling nature: Jesus calmed a storm just by saying the words, “Be still”. Jesus was able to control forces of nature such as wind and rain.

Raising the dead: We know that Jesus rose from the dead to save our sins, but he also raised others from the dead as well. Jesus raised a man named Lazarus from the dead. He was dead for 4 days! Jesus shouted “Lazarus, come out!”, and Lazarus came out of his tomb, perfectly alive.
