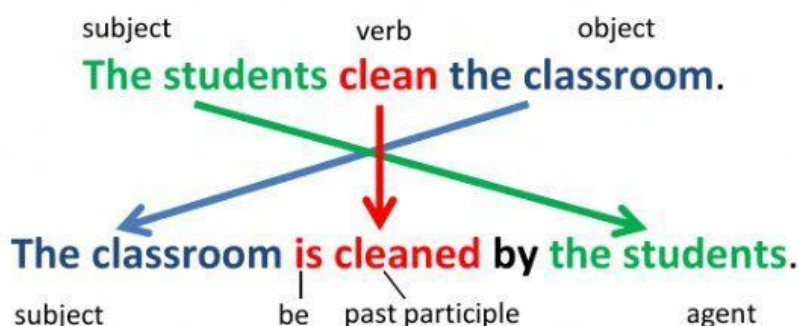


THE PASSIVE VOICE



Forms of TO BE:

1) Present simple: IS/ARE

Bees **produce** honey. – Honey **is produced** by bees.

Ants **make** anthills. – Anthills **are made** by ants.

2) Present continuous: IS BEING/ARE BEING

We **are fulfilling** the task. – The task **is being fulfilled**.

They **are exploring** new areas. – New areas **are being explored**.

3) Past simple: WAS/WERE

Someone **broke** the window yesterday. – The window **was broken** yesterday.

Someone **unleashed** the dogs. – The dogs **were unleashed**.

4) Past continuous: WAS BEING/WERE BEING

They **were praising** the girl. – The girl **was being praised**.

They **were taking** pictures. – Pictures **were being taken**.

5) Present perfect: HAS BEEN/HAVE BEEN

Someone **has made** a hole in the fence. – A hole **has been made** in the fence.

They **have explored** new areas. – New areas **have been explored**.

6) Future simple: WILL BE

They **will laugh** at me again. – I **will be laughed** at again.

They **will humiliate** you again. – You **will be humiliated** again.



7) Modal verbs: MODAL VERB + BE

Anyone **can polish** this surface easily. – This surface **can be polished** easily.

We **must punish** crime. – Crime **must be punished**.

They **would explore** new areas. – New areas **would be explored**.

They **should explore** new areas. – New areas **should be explored**.

We **may make** mistakes. – Mistakes **may be made**.

They **might tell** the truth. – The truth **might be told**.
