


THE ORIENT EXPRESS

The Orient Express was the name of a long-distance European passenger train service originally operated by the "Compagnie Internationale des Wagons-Lits." It ran from 1883 to 2009. Nowadays there is another train called "The Orient Express" but it is run by another company - "Venice-Simplon Orient Express. The most important city names are Paris, France and Istanbul, Turkey. On the train you would find a baggage car, restaurant car, sleeping cars, etc.



The route of the Orient Express changed many times. Although the original Orient Express was simply a normal international railway service, many people think of intrigue and luxury when they hear its name. It was the setting for many famous books such as "Dracula", "Murder on the Orient Express", and "From Russia with Love".
