

PRESENT TENSES: Choose the correct tense:, present simple/progressive, present perfect simple/progressive



These are Lenny, Lara, Louisa and Luke who live in a small village in the mountains. Lara and Louisa (1) **(be)** twins, but they (2) **(not look)** alike. Lenny (3) **(be)** their neighbour and Luke (4) **(not live)** far from them. In their summer holidays the two girls (5) **(get up / always)** at around 8 o'clock, but they (6) **(not have)** breakfast with their parents who (7) **(leave / already)** for work. After breakfast Lara (8) **(run)** to the village square and Louisa (9) **(ride)** her bike. There they (9) **(meet)** the two boys who (10) **(wait)** for them for quite some time.
