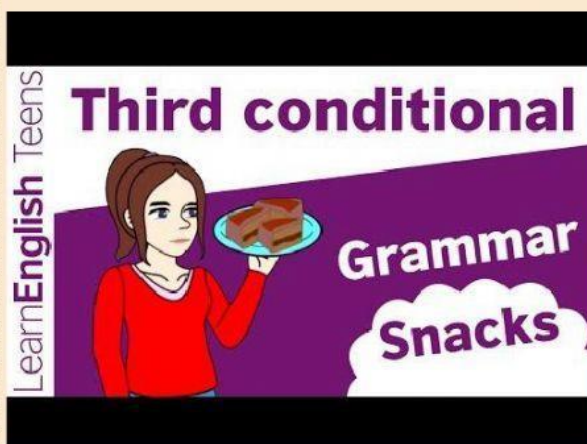
IF + Past Perfect, Perfect Conditional
