## ZERO AND FIRST CONDITIONAL

The Zero conditional is used for things that are always true as long as the condition is met.

Form: If + present tense, + present tense

*If I eat too much, I feel ill.*

The if clause can come before or after the main clause.

If it comes after, we don't use a comma.

*If you heat ice, it melts. Ice melts if you heat it.*

We use the first conditional to express something that is possible will happen in the present or future

**FORM:**

**IF + PRESENT SIMPLE + WILL**

**EXAMPLE: IF I HAVE TIME, I WILL BUY THE NEWSPAPER.**

**IF + PRESENT SIMPLE + IMPERATIVE**

**EXAMPLE: IF YOU SEE TOM, GIVE HIM THIS LETTER**

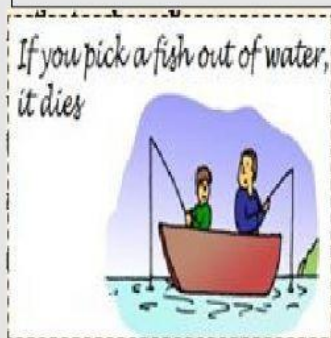
