A. Jonathan Brandis
Jonathan(be) born in 1976. He (begin) his acting career when he (be) only six. He (play) one of his most important roles at the age of 11 in Fatal Attraction. Three years later, he (have) his first leading role in 'The Never-Ending Story II' and in the same year he (star) the mini-series 'It' by Stephen King. Thanks to this role, he (get) his big break in the popular series Sea Quest DSV in 1993. From this moment on, he (become) very popular but the show (be) cancelled in 1996. His popularity (begin)to wane and he (start) struggling to maintain his career. In 2002, he (get) a role in Hart's War, but his scenes (be) discarded. Brandis (get) depressed and (decide) to suicide. On November 11th, 2003 he (hang) himself in his apartment in Los Angeles at the age of 27.
B. Brian Jones
Brian (be) the leader of the Rolling Stones and (be) known because of his talent and master in several instruments. He also (work) with the Beatles in the Yellow Submarine choirs. Unfortunately, he (have) a messy life because of alcohol and drug problems as well as his overweening personality. That same year, Brian (be) found diving into the swimming pool as a result of his foolish behavior. According to the forensic report, he (mix) alcohol and drugs and his liver and heart (be) damaged. However, it is said that Brian (die not) as a result of an accident. In 1993, it was reported that Frank Thorogood, a builder who was working in his garden (kill) him.
C. Andres Escobar
He(be) born in March 1967 and (be) an important footballer in Colombia. He (play) in the World Cup in the USA, 1994. Unfortunately, he (make) a mistake, an own goal. According to the press, it (be) the cause of his death. This mistake (incite) the rage of gamblers who (belong) to drug mafia and (murder) him. However, this hypothesis is not proved yet and there are a lot of questions to be answered about what (lead) his death at the age of 27 in 1994.
D. Janis Joplin

E. Jean-Michael Basquiat
He (be) a poet, a painter and a graffiti artist considered the father of the Urban Movement in relation to graffiti. He (be) born in 1960 in Brooklyn New York. At early age, he (show) an interest in drawing. His parents (support) him and (encourage) his affinity for arts. Years later, he (show) interest in Alfred Hitchcock films, cars and animation. At 18, he (join) the theater group 'Family Life'. By this time, he (sign) his first graffities. In 1984, he (start) to give signs of drug abuse and abnormal behaviors connected to the addiction. In August 1988, he (pass away) because of a heroin overdose.
