Sequence

Describes events in order or explains the steps one must follow to do something or make something

Signal Words

first, second, next, last,
another, then, finally,
after that, before

- use to describe a process or telling events.

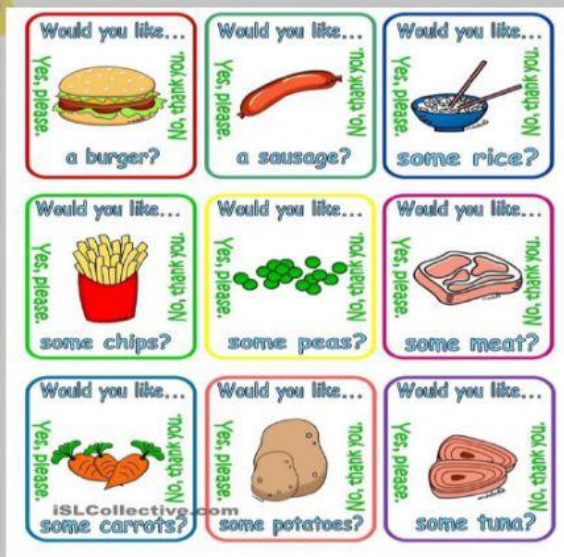
I go to the gym **twice a week.**

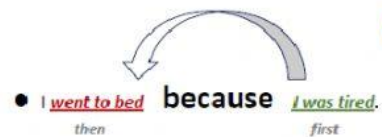
