The extraordinary story of Bonnie and Clyde

When Bonnie Parker met Clyde Barrow in January 1930, she was living in Texas. She was married, but her husband was in prison. Clyde was committing crimes and he soon went to prison too, but Bonnie helped him escape. Then they spent two years on the road. While they were traveling, they frequently robbed banks and stole cars. They committed crimes in different places, from Missouri to New Mexico, and killed thirteen people. The couple quickly became the most famous criminals in the U.S. The police were looking for them and everyone was reading about them in the newspaper. Bonnie and Clyde were trying to escape when police officers finally caught and killed them in Louisiana in May 1934.

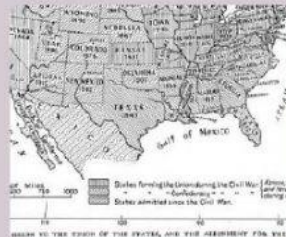
When Bonnie and Clyde committed their crimes, the U.S. was suffering from an economic crisis, the Great Depression. People didn't have much money and

they thought the banks were responsible. Bonnie and Clyde's crimes were appalling, but for some people, they were heroes.

The story of Bonnie and Clyde continues to interest people today. The couple was the subject of a 1967 movie, various songs, a musical, and a 2014 TV series. So why is their story so popular? Maybe it's the idea of a life of adventure on the road. However, it's important to remember that this isn't really a story: Bonnie and Clyde were real people who committed terrible crimes and destroyed many lives.
