



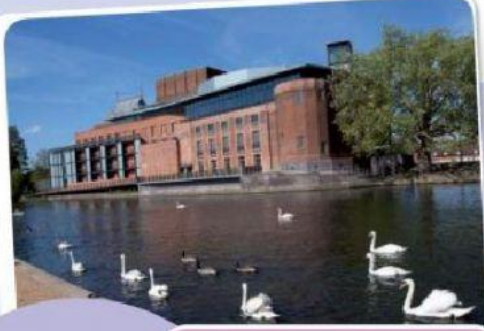

Comparatives (short adjectives)

One-syllable adjectives

adjective + **er than**

quiet → *Stratford is quieter than LA.*

cold → *Stratford is colder than LA.*

Adjectives ending in -e

adjective + **r than**

nice → *Small cities are nicer than big ones.*

safe → *Stratford is safer than LA.*

Two-syllable adjectives ending in -y

adjective - **y + ier than**

dirty → *Big cities are usually dirtier than small cities.*

noisy → *LA is noisier than Stratford.*

Adjectives ending in vowel + consonant

consonant x 2 + **er than**

big → *LA is bigger than Stratford.*

hot → *Rio de Janeiro is hotter than LA.*

Remember!

There is / are + more (less) + noun + (than)...

There are more universities in LA than in Stratford. There's more traffic there too.
