

Simple Predicates Worksheet 2

The **complete predicate** includes all of the details that tell what the subject is or did. The **simple predicate** is the verb in the complete predicate.

Example:

Cory enjoys playing the banjo.

Complete predicate = enjoys playing the banjo

Simple predicate = **enjoys**
