Genesis Ch. 1:27 states, "So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him;" Man is similar to God in the following ways:

1. Man has intelligence (the ability to reason, create , communicate and the power to choose)
2. Man has emotions (joy, anger etc.)
3. Man has a spirit nature.



Compare man's ability to that of other animals

God created man with unique characteristics that the other animals do not possess. These special characteristics include the ability to dominate, speak, reason, create, love, and make choices. While animals can communicate, they cannot speak. They use their instincts and other physical features to survive.
